Campus Updates

We have completed many exciting renovations to several areas on campus with more to



come this academic year. The renovation project for the USC Lancaster campus tennis courts was completed in Fall 2021. All six courts were resurfaced, windscreens replaced, and new awnings installed. We are grateful to Rick Porter, Steve Williams, and Pat Goldsmith for their work in spearheading this project, along with three very generous community partners who donated to this effort: Founders Federal Credit Union, Comporium, and Nutramax Laboratories.

During the summer of 2021, Starr Hall was renovated to include an improved arrival point and main entryway with enhanced visibility, accessibility, and appearance and the reconfiguration of office areas to better accommodate service needs. Improvements to the student center were also completed. Starr Hall serves as a “one-stop shop” for student services,

held on November 10 and included food trucks, prizes, and other activities, and was sponsored through the generosity of one of USCL's corporate partners, the Indian Land, S.C.-based INSP Television Network.

In addition, new landscaping was installed in front of Hubbard Hall, and we will soon begin on the renovation and redesign of the Crawford Rose Garden.
